Dear all who are associated with Sunnydown,

With a busy week ahead, I take the opportunity to remind parents, students and staff that Sunnydown is a school, a place of learning. Though the week ahead is busy, and has less structure than a typical school day, the high expectations regarding work, politeness, behaviour and respect is as relevant next week as any other. The uniform policy has been relaxed to accommodate various trips and activities, but please do check this carefully.

Though I have published the term and Inset dates for 2024-2025 (see below), I am discussing these on Monday evening at FGB. I am considering options regarding the end of the year which finishes on a Monday and Tuesday again in 2025, similar to this year. Such a midweek finish makes coordinating all school activities difficult. If there is to be any change to any Inset days throughout the academic year or indeed the end of the school year in 2025, you will be notified as a priority. Please note that the first half of Autumn term will remain unchanged

I have taken it upon myself to eat lunch in the Year 9 sitting late this week. It was observed that some boys (in all year levels) are eating a main meal and dessert within 10 to 12 minutes and then demanding to go outside. I take this opportunity to remind us that lunch is an opportunity to sit and eat in relative calmness, and not rush the occasion. Eating too hastily can cause indigestion. In addition, the school site is staffed for supervision according to where students are. If students leave the dining hall too early, there will not be adequate staff to supervise, increasing the likelihood of issues between students.

In conversation with your sons, please remind them to attend the school dining hall calmly, dressed in full uniform, without gadgets and footballs and to eat in an appropriate manner. Moving into 2024-2025 it also appears that some support with the use of utensils such as knives and forks will be necessary. I will ask Occupational Support for some advice.

The weather currently looks very good late next week, giving us every chance of a wonderful Sports Day event on Friday 19th. Additional information will be sent separately next week. Suffice to say that parents are welcome to attend the afternoon events, arriving from 12.30pm. Parking will be incredibly tight so please be mindful of local residents and families from our neighbouring schools.

Apparently there is a footy match on Sunday evening being played in Berlin, the outcome of which is important to one and all. May I wish every success to all players, and can only hope that the match is played in the right spirit with the most deserving team winning.
