Over Easter we held another successful holiday scheme with students taking part in hide and seek, chicken hero, water fights, Easter egg treasure hunts, football, tennis, cycling and karaoke - where some hidden talent was revealed. Then going to Sayers Croft to take part in climbing, caving, high ropes, campfire building, blindfold trails and maze exploration. It was a great opportunity for the boys to develop teamwork and resilience, try new things and build confidence. A high point was when Alexander, Michael and Freddie all overcame their fears to complete the high ropes course and it was especially great to see the encouragement and support their peers showed them while they navigated the courses. Freddie had to be helped down by staff after his first attempt but then went straight back up and completed it. I have never seen such a quick turnaround. Another high was seeing the boys develop trust, communication and teamwork while navigating a blindfold trail. Some of the boys' thoughts are below:

Freddie P: My favourite things were Easter egg hunts, zipline and caving, hide and seek and chicken hero Alexander: Doing high ropes helped me get over my fear of heights

*Michael*: It helped me overcome my fear of heights. I was shaking the first time on the tripwire. Then I looked at other boys doing it and after coming back down I went back up.
