### **Presentation Afternoon**

We will be holding our annual Presentation Afternoon on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July. Parents will have the opportunity to join via Google link throughout the afternoon which will be shared with parents closer to the time.

### Roadworks

The traffic light equipment on Whyteleafe Road (junction with Burntwood Lane) is being replaced as it has become obsolete and is in a poor condition. The Council's contractor Yunex will be carrying out these works.

The work will take place from 1 July 2024 for approximately 3 weeks with temporary traffic lights and a road closure in place:

- Whyteleafe Road 3-way temporary traffic lights
- Burntwood Lane Road closure between 8am 5pm to allow works to take place on Whyteleafe Road & the road closure on Burntwood Lane will be 24/7 (the West arm only). An official diversion route will be in place.

Temporary traffic lights and the road closure at this location will cause traffic delays. Please leave additional time for your journeys.
