As part of Surrey County Council's commitment to improving roads and pavements, Burntwood Lane has been selected for Surface Dressing.

We are carrying out Pre-Patching works on Burntwood Lane in preparation for our Surface Dressing Programme in 2024.

The road will be closed from outside number 44 Burntwood Lane to Wapes Lodge roundabout.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – they are keen to deliver the work with minimal disruption to you.

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles to enable the work to proceed as planned.

Please cut back any overgrown vegetation, tree branches, hedges or shrubs from your property that are hanging or growing over the carriageway to expose the full width of the pavement surface before our works start.

The work is weather dependant and can be delayed by bad weather or other factors. Please look at our information boards on site for date changes.

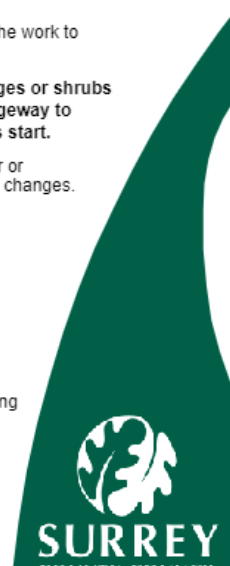
