Sunnydown is designated by the DfES as a COIN (Communication and Interaction Needs) residential and day special school for boys aged 11-16.

It is a weekly boarding school, the boys arriving at school on Monday morning and departing on Friday afternoon. Part time boarding for one, two or three nights is also available. No provision for weekend or holiday boarding currently exists. The school is fully maintained by Surrey Local Education Authority and all pupils have an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP).

All of the pupils who attend Sunnydown School have an EHCP due to their communication and interaction needs and associated difficulties.
