



## BEHAVIOUR PRINCIPALS WRITTEN STATEMENT

**Review Period: Annual      Status: Statutory      Next review Date: Spring 2021**

Under the Education and Inspections Act, 2006, the governing body is charged with the duty to set the framework of the school's policy by providing a written statement of general principles relating to behaviour and discipline, taking into account the needs of all pupils.

The purpose of this statement is to give guidance to the Head teacher in drawing up the Behaviour Management Policy by stating the principles which Governors expect to be followed. The policy aims to underpin the Governors' duty of care to pupils and employees; promote teaching and learning, high standards of attainment and preserve the reputation of the school.

The Governing body expect the following to be covered in the school Behavior Management policy:

- **The right to feel safe at all times**
- **High standards of behavior**
- **Behaviour management strategies**
- **Robust recording of incidents and Communication**
- **Rewards and sanctions**
- **The power to discipline beyond the school gate**

This statement and the Behaviour Management Policy will be reviewed on a minimum three yearly basis, unless changes at national or local level necessitate an exceptional review.
