From the French meaning "a striding over," is a poetic term for the continuation of a sentence or phrase from one line of poetry to the next.

> no pause and the idea keeps going = enjambed

From forth the fatal loins of these two foes A pair of star-cross'd lovers take their life;

> line ends and the thought comes to a close = end-stopped

Say: In-jam-mon

FORM: ENJAMBMENT

• The running over of a line or thought into the next line without a strong break or pause

Example:

I'm feeling rather sleepy, but I really don't know why. I guess it is the way the day has spun out of control.
