Antonym: explicit, obvious, apparent, evident

Adjective

Origin: Latin

Root: *implicatus*
means 'entwined'

Prefix:

Suffix: -ly,
-ion, -ive

Sentences with the word: I have implicit trust in her abilities.
The message was implicit; they should not continue.
